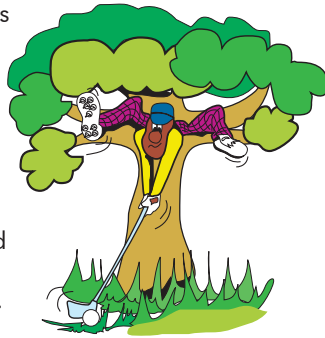


Why Support Glendale Parks & Recreation?

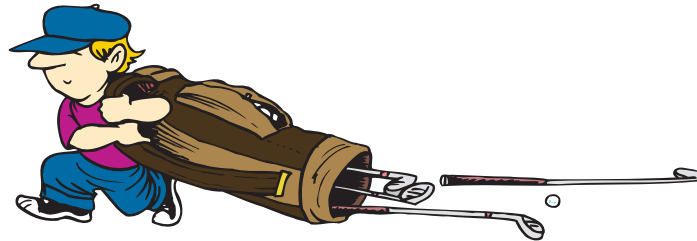


Tournament Details
