Whether your financial hardship is temporary (short-term) or more permanent (long-term), whether you want to keep your home or you have decided that you are ready to sell, or if you're not sure what to do, we can help. There will be an opportunity to receive one-on-one counseling with a HUD certified housing counselor and/or lender representative on-site. We'll work with you to determine whether a loan modification or another solution may work for you.

What to Bring to the Event

- 2 most recent pay stubs showing year-to-date earnings
- 2009 & 2010 signed income tax returns
- Recent utility bill to establish proof of resident
- 2 months recent bank statements (all pages)
- Household expense budget
- Most recent property insurance & mortgage statements
- Letter explaining your hardship
